Township of Warwick Community Improvement Plan (CIP)



The Township of Warwick's Community Improvement Plan (CIP) provides a framework for encouraging redevelopment and reinvestment within the Township of Warwick through the implementation of financial incentives in defined downtown borders in Watford and Warwick Village. The Township of Warwick CIP program includes financial grants for signage, façade improvements, Brownfields redevelopment and historical murals.

CIP Committee

The CIP Committee is made up of 5 local volunteers who are charged with the task of meeting to review relevant applications and policies as they relate to the Township of Warwick CIP and Mural Guidelines. Table 1.1 summarizes the number of CIP Committee meetings that have taken place over the last few years.

In addition to the four (4) formal CIP Committee meetings held in 2015 and 2016, committee members have made extensive efforts to continuously promote the CIP, and its incentives, in the local community through participation in community events. In 2015 the CIP committee took the initiative in representing the Township of Warwick and promoting the Township of Warwick as a recipient of the 2015 - Libro Prosperity Fund.

Applications and Expenditures

In 2015 and 2016 the CIP committee funded \$9860 dollars for signage and façade improvements. The CIP committee allocated \$0 dollars for Murals and Brownfield's grants in 2015 and 2016.

Special Projects- Libro Prosperity Fund (2015)

In 2015 the CIP committee worked on a proposal for submitting an application for a Township of Warwick revitalization grant. An application was submitted to Libro Prosperity Fund(2015). The application outlined a plan to "refresh" the Township of Warwick through the purchase of new downtown amenities to enhance the image of the downtown community. The Committee members were successful in obtaining the \$10,000 grant from Libro. The proposal included providing attractive downtown amenities including 7 waste receptacles and 7 benches (Libro logo) throughout Watford and Warwick Village. The cost for the downtown amenities was 50% percent contribution from Libro's prosperity grant and 50% percent contribution from the Township of Warwick for a total project cost of \$19579.50.

2017 CIP Committee Projects

The CIP committee will continue to work on the following revitalization initiatives in 2017:

- Replacing and adding downtown amenities
- Bluebird square park design and clock relocation
- Community group signage
- Review potential mural locations- Warwick Village Mural
- Continue to promote and provide grants for signage, façade and brownfields redevelopment

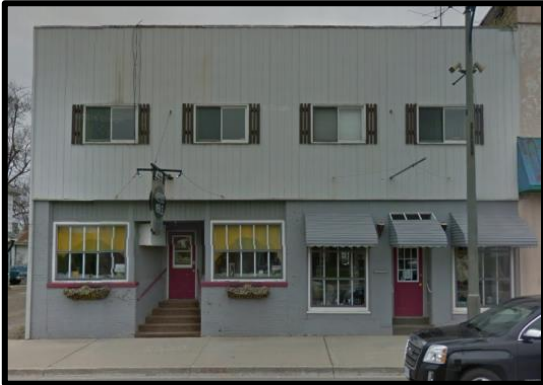
